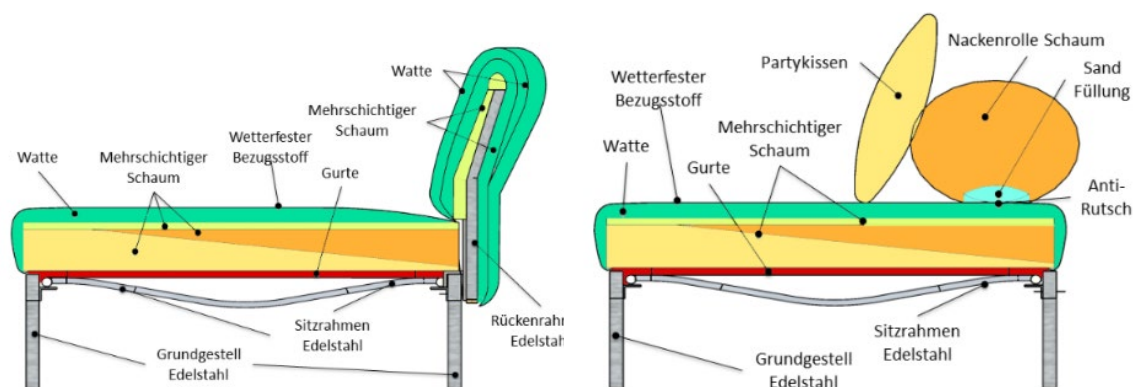

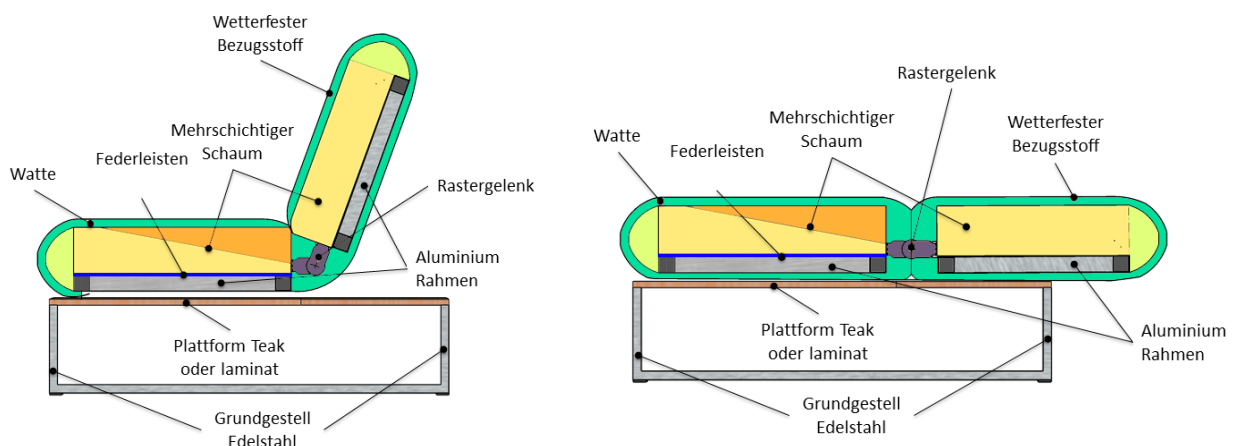
Kairos Lounge

Our Kairos Lounge is made of the highest quality materials. The basic structure is a stainless-steel frame. Multi-layered foam with a cover of wadding and the outdoor fabrics, weatherproof through waterproof ticking or lamination, form the shell of our outdoor sofa. The high seating comfort of the sofa is guaranteed by the use of straps. The special feature of the Kairos Lounge is its high degree of individualisation and flexibility, as the back sections are always removable and can, for example, be replaced by a back roll. Furthermore, the lounge is available in different lengths and widths. So everyone can put together their own individual sofa.



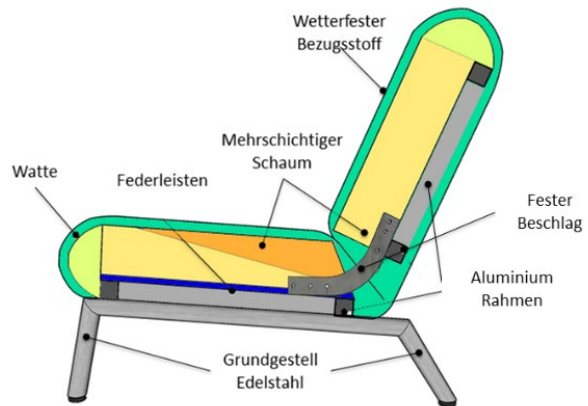
Flora Lounge

The Flora and Luna Lounge use an innovative suspension made of fibreglass-reinforced plastic slats that perfectly cushions the body at every point without it sinking in too deeply. Regardless of body proportions, the back is optimally supported in every position. At the same time, the materials guarantee constant elasticity and a much longer durability than slats or springs. Luna Lounge

Our Luna Lounge differs from the Flora by its simpler substructure. While the Flora Lounge has an adjustable back, the back of the Luna is fixed. The optional side parts are adjustable, as with the Flora Lounge. All our lounges are equipped with Sunbrella cover fabrics which are weatherproof thanks to internal lamination (Natte waterproof) or an additional waterproof ticking fabric.

Easy care

The fabrics are characterised by simple and uncomplicated cleaning.



Breathable

Due to a breathable fabric, Sunbrella fabrics only need a short time to dry.



Mould resistant

Dirt and waterlogging can cause mould stains. Due to a special fungicidal coating, Sunbrella fabrics are not affected by this and are far ahead of other outdoor cushions in their development.



Water & dirt repellent

A special water bath after weaving gives the fabrics a water- and dirt-repellent layer.



UV protection

The fibres of the individual threads are completely dyed. This gives the spinneret-dyed acrylic a high level of UV protection.



Colourfast

Thanks to the completely dyed fibres, the fabrics are absolutely colourfast and retain this property for a long time.

Washing instructions for all fabrics



Cleaning tips

Beer	White vinegar
Fruits/Berries (red)	Water + ammonia (max. 3-6% solution)
Coffee	White vinegar
Cola	Water + soap
Chocolate	treat with lemon juice / detergent (rub)
Chewing gum	Solvent containing acetone
Butter, cooking fat	Solvent containing acetone
Engine oil/grease	If necessary, soften and dilute with oil, then wash out with solvent containing acetone.
Pencil, charcoal	Vacuum, then use cleaning agent
Ink, coloured pencils	Soak in milk for several hours and rinse with cold water or concentrated alcohol (90%).
Lipstick	Trichloroethylene or hydrogen peroxide (20 %)
Mould	Bleaching lye (max. 10%) + soap
Shoe polish	Solvent containing acetone
Grass	Dab with cotton wool soaked in methylated spirit, then rinse with clean water.
Rust	stretch the dirty part over a saucepan of boiling water, sprinkling with citric acid, then rinse with clean water.
Blood	stretch over a saucepan and rinse with water containing ammonia (3 to 6% max.)
Sweat and urine	White vinegar or slightly ammoniacal water
Vomit	Washing-up liquid or white vinegar
Candle wax	Dampen a towel with cleaner containing acetone, cover the fabric with it, then iron over it with an iron.
Wine	White vinegar or slightly ammoniacal water
